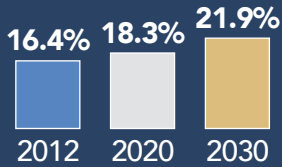


# CALIFORNIA LEADS THE NATION IN NUMBER OF RESIDENTS OVER AGE 60



PERCENTAGE OF CALIFORNIA'S POPULATION **OVER 60**<sup>1</sup>



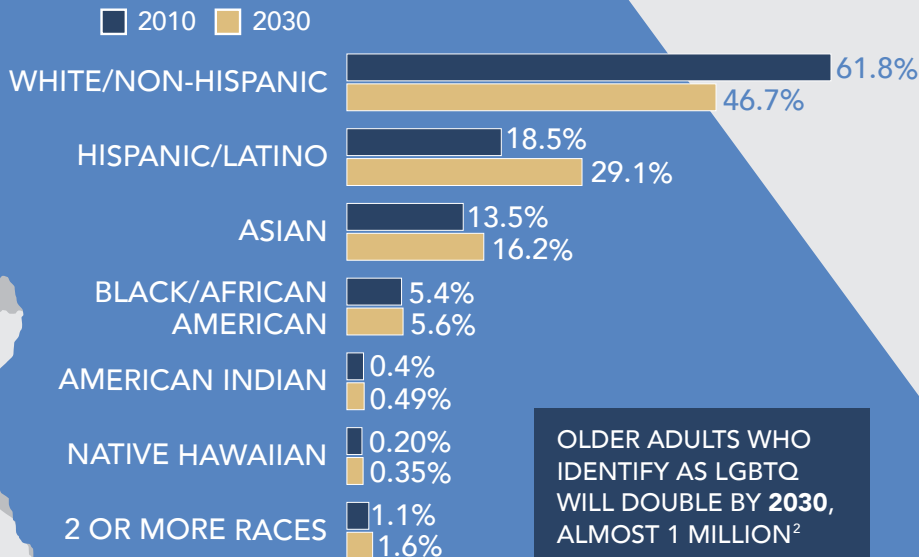
