CalSWEC News

- Two new Board members
 - Kari Beureman, LCSW, Marin County Social Services Director
 - [Shelby Boston](#), MSW, Butte County Employment and Social Services Director & Title IV-E Graduate
- \$75,000 grant from BASSC for the Adult Protective Services Stipend Program Work Group.
- Participated in a \$8 million joint funding proposal to augment child welfare training statewide.

Program Highlights

- Current CalSWEC portfolio valued at \$100 million.
- Launch of a fully updated CalSWEC Student Information System (CSIS) database and associated processes to the Salesforce platform .
- Amendments to CalSWEC's three-year contract for the RTA contract is in process.
- Secured HRSA funding to train MSW students in medication assisted treatment for opioid use disorders.

Program Highlights (cont'd)

- Secured OSHPD funding for 2018-19 MHSAs Stipend Program.
- 1,300+ responses collected in the first wave of the Title IV-E Retrospective Study.
- Data collection for Contra Costa County Workforce Study completed.
- Collaboration with CDSS on a statewide Learning Management System advances.
- CalSWEC moves to Haviland mid-December 2018. (Yay!)
